

HOSPITAL SELECTION CRITERIA FOR M.P.K.A.Y.


All unit commanders should follow the following criteria for selection of the network hospital under M.P.K.A.Y. scheme.


Network Hospital :- Network hospital mean the hospital with which the service provider shall enter into a agreement between First Party, Second Party and Hospital for providing cashless hospitalization facilities to the beneficiaries under the M.P.K.A.Y. Scheme with Central Government Health Scheme Hospital Tariff dated 09/07/2002.


- 1) The Network Hospital should be multi specialty hospital, means
 - I) All faculty should be available in the hospital.
 - II) All the 32 ailments should be treated as per the G.R. dated 19.03.2005 expect for the special category e.g. Cancer.
 - III) Intensive care cardiac facility (I.C.C.U.) with cardiac ventilator and N.I.C.U.
 - IV) Full time intecivist 24 hours.
 - V) Fully equipped major operation theatre.
 - VI) Ventilator.
 - VII) Availability of the all the branch consultant either full time or on call basis e.g. Cardiologist, Physician, Orthopedic, Gynecologist, General Surgeon, Neurologist, Oncologist, Ophthalmologist, Plastic Surgeon, pediatric, Vascular Surgeon etc.
 - VIII) Network Hospital should have ambulance services, blood bank facility, CT scan, MRI centre either by in house or tie up with other external agencies, network hospital should provide the above services under cashless admissions as per C.G.H.S. rates only.

- 2) The Network Hospital should have registered under all necessary registration certificate for establishment of hospitals.
- 3) The Network Hospital should have the admission facility as under.
A and B Grade City – 50 beds and above.
C and D Grade City – 25 beds and above.
The Network Hospital should have Ward as per the following Ward Definition :-
 - a) General Ward :- Maximum 6 patients in one hall.
 - b) Semi Private Ward :- 2 patients in one room with attached toilets / Air Condition room.
 - c) Private Room :- Air Conditioner room with attached toilets, single sharing room.
- 4) The Network Hospital should have Pathology, X-ray, Sonography, Pharmacy Shop in the premises of the hospital with computerized pharmacy billing.
- 5) The network hospital should have Residence Medical Officer ratio of 1 : 10
A and B grade city minimum 5 R.M.O.s and for C and D grade city minimum 3 R.M.O.s should be available.
- 6) Maharashtra Nursing Council Nursing Staff ratio should be 1 : 3 for A and B grade city minimum 16 nursing staff and C and D grade city minimum 8 nursing staff should be available.
- 7) Government recognized hospital should be considered on priority.
- 8) The network hospital should have separate desk for cashless admission counter.

- 9) The network hospital should have internet connectivity of the hospital and computerized billing system to facilitate the online computerized admission, approval and claim settlement .
- 10) The network hospital should provide ⁴⁵~~60~~ days of credit period for M.P.K.A.Y.
- 11) The network hospital should have canteen facilities.


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
